Dear Friends of Living River,

We have exciting news to share!

Financial News

- Living River's line of credit has been replaced with a mortgage.
- A mortgage for \$498,000 has been obtained from Oakworth Capital Bank. (This is compared to a line of credit for \$849,000 this time last year.)
- Our monthly mortgage payments are \$2,513. This fall the Presbytery of Sheppards and Lapsley sold the
 property that housed the former Trinity Presbyterian Church. Ninety percent of the proceeds from that
 sale are designated for Living River. The Presbytery will forward \$2,792 per month to Living River which
 will cover our monthly mortgage payments.
- Now that a plan is in place to eliminate our debt, our next step toward financial stability is covering our
 operational costs with sustained monthly giving from those interested in the future of Living River.
